

SAINT CHARLES COUNTY ROAD BOARD

Minutes of
September 12, 2022

The Wednesday, September 12, 2022, special meeting of the St. Charles County Road Board was called to order at 4:00 p.m. via TEAMS, by Matthew Johannesman, Chairman.

Roll Call – was taken by Amanda Brauer.

Public Comment – There was none.

Discussion of St. Charles County Strategic Highway Safety Plan

Amanda Brauer presented current status of the St. Charles County Strategic Highway Safety Plan and submitting an implementation application that is part of US DOT Safe Streets for all grant. The implementation application has a submittal deadline of September 15, 2022. The Action Plan will serve as a guiding document for residents, employers, public officials, law enforcement, and advocates to identify the extent of the safety challenge and the most effective action steps to make our communities safer. Traffic deaths are preventable, and this plan is an important step in realizing a safer St Charles County. St Charles County is committed to providing a safe transportation system for all by reducing fatal and serious injury crashes by 50% by 2030 and eliminating fatal and serious injury crashes by 2050. These goals are consistent with the State of Missouri’s which states “every day can be a zero day” and the East-West Gateway Council of Government’s goal of zero roadway deaths.

Amanda Brauer mentioned design could start in 2023 with construction in 2024. However, the project application requires approval of the project prior to being submitted and a commitment of reducing fatal and serious injury crashes by 50% by 2030 and eliminating fatal and serious injury crashes by 2050.

Road Board Recommendation Action - St. Charles County Strategic Highway Safety Plan

It was moved by Brian Pundmann and seconded by James Tognoni to approve the St. Charles County Strategic Highway Safety Plan project. The motion carried unanimously.

Other Business – There was none.
