

County still reviewing possibility of women's indoor football at Family Arena

St. Charles County, Missouri - No decision has been made about the possibility of the Family Arena hosting two women's indoor football league games in 2013, County Executive Steve Ehlmann said Monday morning.

"Whoever announced this jumped the gun," Ehlmann said. "They (the Lingerie Football League) talked to us last year and we turned them down. They came to us again this year, and we took it to a policy committee to review. They found the league did not violate our policy on events at the Family Arena. So we're talking with the league. But there is no contract."

Ehlmann said the concerns about the lack of insurance for players "could be a deal-breaker."

"We're looking into that," he said. "But if the league only provides up to \$10,000 coverage for players, that's something we will have to consider."

As of now, the Lingerie Football League is not booked for any events at the county-owned Family Arena.
