

Portage Road To Close For Two Months At Rees Road

St. Charles County, Missouri - A portion of Portage Road will be closed beginning at 7:30 a.m. Monday, June 11, to allow for construction of two box culverts. The road will remain closed for approximately two months. The construction area is located at the intersection of Portage Road and Rees Road.

Portage Road will remain open on either side of the closure area, but no through traffic will be allowed through the area of the culvert replacement. Rees Road will remain open, but no traffic will be able to access Portage Road from Rees Road or vice versa.

On the west side of Rees Road, motorists may take Grafton Ferry Road to Highway 94 to Rees Road to Weber Lake Road to by-pass the closure. On the east side of Rees Road, motorists may take Weber Lake Road to Rees Road to Highway 94 to by-pass the closure. Signs notifying motorists of the closure and detour route will be posted.

This road project is part of a continuing effort by St. Charles County Government to improve the county's road system for the safety of the traveling public.
