

Forest Green Drive To Close For Two Months

St. Charles County, Missouri - A portion of Forest Green Drive will be closed at 7:30 a.m. on Monday, Aug. 13, to allow for the replacement of the crossroad culvert. The road will remain closed for approximately two months. The construction area is located between Oak Ridge and Forest View Drive south of Highway P.

Forest Green Drive will remain open on either side of the closure area, but no through traffic will be allowed through the area of the culvert replacement. Motorists may take Highway P to Deer Creek Drive to Forest View Drive to by-pass the closure. Signs notifying motorists of the closure and detour route will be posted.

This road project is part of a continuing effort by St. Charles County Government to improve the county's road system for the safety of the traveling public.
