**Bolden Found Guilty by Jury for Robbery 1<sup>st</sup> and Armed Criminal Action**

**ST. CHARLES COUNTY, MISSOURI- THE OFFICE OF PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TIM LOHMAR**

announces that Darrell Ivan Bolden Jr, 39, of St. Louis, was found guilty by a jury of two counts Robbery 1<sup>st</sup> and two counts armed criminal action.

Charges arose from May 5, 2012 when Bolden entered a Check ‘n Go in St. Peters with a weapon and robbed the manager as well as a customer in the store. Neither person in the robbery was injured. Bolden was found guilty by jury in St. Louis County in February 2014 for robbery 1<sup>st</sup> and armed criminal action is currently serving a life sentence in the Missouri Department of Corrections.

Judge Pelikan presided over the jury trial and has set sentencing on April 6, 2015 at 9:00 am.
