Curtis Sentenced to 22 years in MDOC

ST. CHARLES COUNTY, MISSOURI- The Office of Prosecuting Attorney Tim Lohmar announces that Joshua Curtis, 36, of Winfield, MO plead guilty to Assault 1st degree and Armed Criminal Action and was sentenced to 22 years in the Missouri Department of Corrections.

Charges arose on November 29, 2017 when Curtis opened fire striking a teacher jogging in a commonly used trail at Francis Howell High School. The victim was able to identify Curtis having jogged passed him before Curtis fired. Once Curtis shot the victim, he fell to his knees and was able to look over his shoulder and observe Curtis pointing a hand gun at him.

Curtis was sentenced by the Honorable Jon Cunningham. Curtis will be required to serve 85% of his sentence before being eligible for parole.
