Beatty Receives 30 Years Following Armed Attack

St. Charles County, Missouri- The Office of Prosecuting Attorney Tim Lohmar announces that Jerry L. Beatty of Wentzville was sentenced to 30 years in prison today. Beatty, 53, was previously convicted by a jury in February ([see previous story](#)). Beatty was convicted of 3 felonies and 2 misdemeanors after attempting to shoot his ex-girlfriend in an incident where the gun failed to discharge.

The 30-year sentence was handed down by the Honorable Judge Nancy Schneider for a charge of armed criminal action. Beatty received 15 years in prison for both domestic assault and burglary. He also received a year in jail for the misdemeanor charges of resisting arrest and the violation of an order of protection. The sentences will be served concurrently. Judge Schneider cited the facts of the case, Beatty's pattern of behavior, as well as his lack of remorse and credibility when handing down her sentence.
