St. Charles Peeping Tom Taken into Custody

St. Charles County- The Office of Prosecuting Attorney Tim Lohmar has issued charges against Freddie Cleveland, 31, of the 4200 block of Randall Place in St. Louis. Cleveland is charged with one count of Invasion of Privacy of Multiple Individuals, a class D felony.

Cleveland was observed peering into the windows at the Time Centre Apartments in St. Charles on May 19, 2014. After a witness identified him, Cleveland was stopped by the St. Charles City Police Department. The investigation revealed that Cleveland had been peeping into windows for six to eight months and had looked into over 75 windows. Multiple individuals were viewed in a partial or full state of undress during the incident on May 19.

Cleveland is currently in the custody at the St. Charles County jail and is being held on a cash-only bond of \$50,000. The date of his first court appearance is still pending.
