Livingston Receives Shock Time in Wet Cell Phone Case

St. Charles County, Missouri- The Office of Prosecuting Attorney Tim Lohmar announces that Trevor Livingston, of St. Peters, entered a plea of guilty to assault charges on January 13, 2014. These charges stem from an attack last November after Livingston discovered his cell phone in a puddle of water. Livingston attacked a woman with a pair of scissors and attempted to choke her. The Hon. Judge Jon Cunningham sentenced Livingston to 60 days of shock time in the county jail. Livingston must also serve 5 years on probation, attend anger management classes, and cannot possess weapons.
