### Cabin & Tent Camping Reservation Procedures

There are two types of camping facilities to reserve throughout the year within the St. Charles County regional parks system – tent camping sites and rustic camping cabins. Camping cabins and tent camping sites are available to rent at Klondike Park in Augusta. In addition, a large Group Camping Area that accommodates up to 200 guests and individual sites are available to rent at Indian Camp Creek Park near Wentzville. Guests must be 18 years of age to reserve a facility and be present during their stay. Check-in is at 3 p.m. and check-out at noon the next day. The shower house at Klondike Park is closed and water is turned off from Nov. 1 through March 31. Non-flushable composting restrooms are open year-round in both parks.

**Camping Cabins:** The sturdy cabins sleep up to eight guests and have two bunk beds, a loft and pull out futon couch, ceiling fan, light, electrical outlet, indoor table, outdoor picnic table, grill and fire ring. Guests must provide their own linens. Cabins are \$65 per night and can only be reserved in advance by using our online reservation system or by contacting the St. Charles County Parks Administrative Offices during business hours at **636-949-7535**.

**Tent Camping Sites:** Each campsite is limited to two tents with a maximum of five guests and feature a picnic table and fire ring. Tent Camping sites are \$10 per night. Camping limited to 14 consecutive days within a 30-day period. No refunds for reservations under \$20, or less than 30 days prior to original reservation.

**How to Reserve a Camping Cabin or Tent Camping Site:** Camping Cabins must be reserved in advance by using our online reservation system at [stccparks.org](http://stccparks.org) or by contacting the St. Charles County Parks Department Administrative Office at **636-949-7535**. Online reservations may be booked at least four days prior to reservation date. Phone reservations may be booked at least one day prior to reservation date during the hours of 8 a.m. and 3 p.m., Monday through Friday only.

If it is after hours and past the online reservations period, guests may “walk-in” and reserve any available campsite. To do so, retrieve a campsite fee envelope from the black mailbox located at the information kiosk near the shower house. Fill out the manila envelope and place exact fee amount inside. Remove the perforated tabs from the envelope and place one on your vehicle windshield and clip the other to the empty campsite marker or post of your choice. Reserved campsites will already have a tab clipped to the campsite marker or post. Place the sealed completed envelope with fee inside the large metal box located adjacent to the information kiosk.

**St. Charles County Parks Rangers check on campers daily. If you have a reservation and need to check-in or have a problem that requires assistance from a park ranger, please call 314-713-4394. Call 911 for all emergencies.**
